(<u>www.candoresourcecenter.com</u>).

The shared vision of **Expanding the Circle of Success**[™] is to facilitate the distribution and donation of 100 million dollars worth of resources for personal, organizational and community empowerment, enlightenment and transformation through an international infrastructure of 10,000 locally initiated Empowerment Resource Centers[™] and ETMS[™] (Empowerment Training Mentoring Systems) over the next 10 years.


CENTER SPACE will be self-sustaining within a few months. The various income streams include: memberships; donations: grants; sponsorships; tuition and related product sales from seminars, workshops, resource showcases and large-scale development training events; consulting services; speakers bureau fees; affiliate program revenue; and the publishing, producing and distributing of books, digital publications, audio video programs and coaching services.

CENTER SPACE is filing an application for IRS recognition as a 501(c)(3) organization and the initial projected first year's budget is \$108,857. CENTER SPACE is preparing to receive Interim funding of up to \$50,000 to cover the first six months of the project through seed grants and other potential funding avenues.

These include: sponsorships; Program Related Investments; advance purchases of marketing, visioning, strategic planning consulting services; revenue participation agreements; fundraising events; advance from a publisher; loans; Lifetime Charter Memberships, general memberships; or equity in affiliated companies. A tentative Use of Proceeds for the \$50,000 and the draft annual budget for the first year are available.

CENTER SPACE will contribute to the Expanding the Circle of Success project by offering all of its proprietary products on a "pay it forward" and "pay what it's worth to you" basis. The initial suite of programs and products that will be shared with CENTER SPACE members includes:

The developments reported in the attached article reprinted from the Muncie, Indiana Times the day after the Success Center Partnership event with Les Brown for youth went on to win recognition by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the National Association of Housing and Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO).

Quotes from Newspaper Articles about Training Programs Produced by CAN DO! and the Community Development Resource Center Established by Charles Betterton and CENTER SPACE

"When we brought Les Brown here last fall, no one knew what to expect," said CAN DO! President Gary Moore. "The organization was prepared to take a loss of \$10,000 just to start bringing a positive message to our community." Instead they made a profit. And they made a plan: to bring every major motivational speaker to the area until Kankakee becomes known as a Mecca of Motivation. "Our mission is to make a positive difference . . . to help people resolve their problems and look at the positive side of life " said Moore.

Walter Charlton, retired entrepreneur and active philanthropist who cofounded CAN DO! "We hope that by bringing top motivational speakers here, we will create a more positive attitude to help residents realize this is a good place to live."

"Through the vision and expertise of Charles Betterton, president of CENTER SPACE, we created CAN DO! as an example to help other communities learn how to produce these types of events while retaining the income they generate for community benefit," Charlton said. CENTER SPACE's mission is to foster spiritual, personal and community empowerment, partly by providing expanded access to state-of-the-art development training programs that are usually marketed to a small percentage of the population.

The members of the CAN DO! Steering Committee which produced the recent events with Les Brown and Dr. John Bowling, have declared their first event a success and they have decided to continue with their efforts. The CAN DO! Mission statement includes five major points:

- 1. Foster community unity and multicultural understanding.
- 2. Promote positive thinking within and about Kankakee County.
- 3. Foster personal, organizational and community development and empowerment.
- 4. Provide expanded access to development training programs.
- 5. Generate funds for worthwhile community service projects.

According to Walter J. Charlton, President of the Kankakee County Community Development Corporation that Charles Betterton had founded before he served as Director of Community and Economic Development for the City of Kankakee, said the first CAN DO! Events exceeded their expectations. "Our initial goals were to have 5 sponsors, five co-sponsors, 200 workshop participants and 1,000 seminar participants.

We actually had 10 sponsors, 10 co-sponsors, 350 people for the workshops and about 1,400 for the seminar. Even though we provided full or partial scholarships to over 200 students, we still generated approximately \$12,000 in net profits for the events. These funds will be used to support the KCDC and provide seed money for future training programs."

They will help involve some other people in lifting their lives and enhancing their sense of self and moving onto some kind of community agenda beyond just what happens to their own lives."

"They can then take a greater interest in what happens in the comunity at large. As these young people get together, reach out to engage others, and get involved, there will be an even greater positive impact within the community and perhaps throughout the nation" Brown added.



It is my pleasure to introduce to you the person who introduced me to community economic development and the work of the 2,500 Community Development Corporations (CDC's) in America. Charles Betterton, President and CEO of CENTER SPACE, the Center for Spiritual, Personal and Community Empowerment, asked me to send you this letter of introduction. It is my understanding that Charles has been invited by Beth Quarles of Future Choices and Henry Fuse of the Muncie Housing Authority to help create a combination Community Economic Development Resource Center and Center for Successful Living in downtown Muncie. Because I have know Mr. Betterton for years and am familiar with his many talents and accomplishments, I am pleased to provide the following information for your consideration.

Charles is a community economic development specialist with many years of successful experience at the national, state and local levels. I met him in 1991 just after I had assumed the Executive Director position for the United Way of Kankakee County, Illinois. Charles had left his position as Executive Director of the City's Community and Economic Development Department to establish an Illinois Community Economic Development Association with grants from the National Congress for Community Economic Development.

Charles also established the Kankakee County CDC and developed a proposal to convert a vacant National Guard Armory building into a Community Economic Development Resource Center. At his invitation, I agreed to serve on the CDC Board of Directors, and I had the opportunity to work closely on the project which won an award from the Governor's Hometown Award Program for successfully mobilizing community resources in ways that fostered community unity and expanded educational opportunities for low and moderate income residents. During the past few years under Charles' guidance and direction, hundreds of thousands of dollars from public and private sources were generated to renovate and equip the Center and to design and deliver the educational programs now proposed for the Muncie CED Resource Center, which include Successful Life and Work Skills Classes and Micro-Enterprise Development (self-employment training).

During the three years I served in Kankakee, I had many opportunities to work with Charles on various projects. For example, Charles, the State's Attorney and I were the initiators of a series of Town Summit meetings based on the Making the Grade Model which were designed to mobilize the community to assess and address the issues impacting youth and their success in life. I also participated in the Strategic Planning for the City of Kankakee's application for HUD designation as an Enterprise Community. Charles had been hired by the city to direct the process which the Mayor credits with enabling it to obtain millions of dollars in subsequent funding.

I also had an opportunity to participate in one of the motivational development training programs Charles produced for the community featuring Brian Tracy, one of the world's top trainers. Charles has also successfully produced similar events with Dr. Norman Vincent Peale, Les Brown and Jim Rohn. As a result of his introducing a community development approach, the scope of the conference was significantly expanded to include client and business leader participation in the conference. The highly positive response to Charles' contributions, such as introducing participants to the Three Round Method of Brainstorming, was documented in the conference proceedings and evidenced in the fact that various committees have been formed to proceed toward the higher vision Charles helped the community evolve and commit to bringing forth. In fact, there are three groups presently working on proposals to bring Charles back to Utica to help maintain progress toward related projects. These include a group which is beginning to plan for the

conversion of a former school building into a community resource center and the two groups interested in Charles' CAN DO program.

Charles has a demonstrated ability to successfully direct the evolution of a vision or concept into manifestation of the vision into reality, and he has generated millions of dollars from private and public sources including helping the United Way of Kankakee County obtain funding for building chambers of commerce and for non-profit organizations. He conducted strategic planning for the Area Wide Human Development Program while he was in Utica this past March. As a result, the committee now has a clear vision of our desired future and a strategy for moving toward our vision, and we have identified the goals and objectives required to accomplish our mission.

When I read through the recently published Summary Report on A Forum On Community Economic Development sponsored by the United Way of America, I became even more aware of the benefits I have received from knowing and working with Charles. The report on the October 1995 Forum which considered how both the values and principles of community economic development relate to United Way's mission, includes the conclusion that: "Unless United Way and the human-service system begin to address the underlying economic status of families and neighborhoods, human services will have limited impact on the lives of low-income individuals." Les Brown's third county appearance to be at Olivet

When Les Brown appeared in Kankakee in May, 1990 and again in Bradley in March, 1991 for the Bradley-Bourbonnais Chamber of Commerce annual dinner, organizers of both events believed that there were several positive results.

There was an "increased level of awareness" by people here of the need and power of vision, positive thinking and working together.

A secondary effect, but maybe even more important, was the sense among the residents that if Kankakee County had the foresight to bring nationally known speakers the level of Brown, Dr. Norman Vincent Peale who was with Brown in 1990 and motivational guru Brian Tracey, then this must be a good place to live and work.

It convinced them that the "can do" spirit of the community was very much there and revivable in a big way. Now, five years later, community leaders want to follow-up with a continuation of the feeling engendered then.

While that is true, one of the minuses in the project is the fact that at the end, the speakers leave and take the community's money with them.

A way to keep the resources at home while still bringing effective programs to the area was believed to be needed.

Walter J. Charlton, head of

the Kankakee Community Development Corporation and others including Doug Perry from Olivet Nazarene University, Richard Clark of the Heritage Foundation, Ray DeWitte of ServantCor/St. Mary's, Al Lemon of Riverside, Gary Moore of Moore Industries and Lisa Kelly of the Working Woman's Council joined forces to form the Kankakee County Can Do!

This organization has as its major emphasis the continuation of efforts to bring programs, trainers and speakers to the community to aid in developing and furthering the spirit of accomplishment needed to move forward. At the same time, the group plans to make the events selfsupporting while generating revenue to support other programs.

Its first event is the return of Les Brown to the area on

Thursday, Nov. 16. Brown will conduct a four hour workshop at Chalfant Hall on the campus of Olivet Nazarene University in Bourbonnais in the afternoon. This workshop will be open to anyone.

The evening will be reserved for a two hour seminar in Chalfant given by Brown. This event will be open to 2,000 people.

The workshop will cost \$150 per person and includes workbooks and interactive materials. The seminar will be \$25.

Discounts of 20 percent will be available for students, senior citizens and groups of two or more.

One-quarter of the funds raised will be used to support Kankakee County Can Dol; fifty percent will go to KCDC and the remaining funds will go to Center Space, a nonprofit organization headed by Charles Betterton. Center Space provides educational programs and materials to foster "spiritual, personal, organizational and community empowerment, addresses discrimination, prejudice and neighborhood tension and facilitates cooperative and creative problem solving efforts among individuals, groups, communities and organizations."

Betterton was director of the city of Kankakee's community and economic development program from 1988 through 1990.

Betterton seeks to motivate

Charles Betterton has a vision: a Kankakee filled with successful, motivated people. He knows there are motivational resources out there that change lives.

His own life was changed at age 16 when his mother gave him a copy of "The Power of Positive Thinking" by Norman Vincent Peale.

Other people respond to audio and videotapes, seminars or even one-on-one success coaching. Betterton's vision is to make all these things available in one place.

"For a number of years, I have been developing a plan for helping more people take advantage of state-of-the-art development training resources," he said. "I think it can best be done through a network of locally initiated learning Centers, he said.

Betterton's local venture, the University for Successful Living, offers a "smorgasbord of resources", including motivational and inspirational cassette tapes, access to national quality motivational speakers, classes on time management, and success coach training.

The USL also gives other communities the chance to establish their own Centers for Successful Living. A showcase Friday will present Kankakee County with an overview of what is available.

Betterton calls the Center for Successful Living Showcase, an all-day event at the downtown Kankakee Executive Centre, a chance for area businesses and non-profit organizations to spend the day experiencing hour- long mini-sessions that demonstrate different motivational resources.

Registration is \$25 a person for the half-day session or \$50 for the full day. It will also give them an opportunity to regain their inspiration and learn how to motivate others. Betterton, 49, will be one of four professional trainers making the presentations.

He has created a number of the seminars and workshops himself. "I've been designing development training seminars for 25 years. My first program, the Introduction to Personal and Professional Success Techniques, is still in use. In fact, it's one of the 10 programs offered at the showcase," he said.

He is also affiliated with and owns distributorships for a number of related success-oriented programs.

Betterton of Stelle arrived from his home state of Mississippi about 20 years ago with a long history of accomplishments. By the time he was 19, he was involved in community development in the Mississippi Delta, establishing a youth program where 'kids of both races could get together and hang out."

That experience led to work in the National Disaster Relief Program, where at 24, Betterton set a record by finding housing for 107 homeless Xenia, Ohio tornado victims in one day. He has served as Kantakee's Director of Community and Economic Development, a position he assumed at the request of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

By that time, he had picked up a master's degree in Community Economic Development and had become a certified trainer - one of 200 world-wide for Brian Tracy International. He was a co-founder of the local CAN DO! and is now working on establishing CAN DO! Organizations and Centers for Successful Living in other areas.

Betterton says the centers can also make available a wealth of state-of- the-art training and development resources. "These resources are usually targeted only to the top 5 percent of the people in corporate America," Betterton said. "What makes the centers special is our commitment to reach as many of the other 95 percent as possible." When the local CSLs bring in a speaker, the profit generated stays in the community.

A Les Brown/Norman Vincent Peale speaking engagement in 1990 drew a standing room only crowd to Kankakee. "People from over 200 cities came to that event," said Betterton.

Betterton is simultaneously working on a Success Center Partnership with the housing authority in Muncie, Ind., which he later hopes to introduce to some 3,500 public housing authorities throughout the country.

He just returned from a trip to the Bahamas, where he conducted strategic planning and visioning exercises for the Bahamas Association for Social Health, the Unity Church of the Bahamas, and Vision 2020 - a group of 30 leaders who want the island nation to lead the world in innovation and creativity. He will return to the Bahamas this month to continue strategic planning. The Sunday Journal, September 20, 1998

Betterton selected for fellowship

Charles Betterton has been selected for one of 230 Community Builder Fellowships out of 8,500 applicants by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The fellowship, worth about \$250,000 over two years, includes a month's study at the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard.

Betterton worked for HUD for several years before he was appointed director of the Kankakee Community Development Agency in 1988. Since leaving the City of Kankakee in 1990, Betterton received a master's in community economic development from New Hampshire College.

Recently he has been focusing on Center Space and the University for Successful Living, two non-profit organizations he founded to provide development training and consulting services through an international network of Centers for Successful Living.

Last month, motivational speaker Les Brown donated more than \$50,000 worth of his services to support the Success Center Partnership that Betterton created for the Muncie, Ind., Housing Authority. During the next few months, the University for Successful Living is donating up to \$50,000 worth of development training to area residents who participate in the Success Mastery Academy with Brian Tracy.

On Nov. 19, the University for Successful Living will produce a workshop and seminar with Mark Victor Hansen, co-author of the best-selling "Chicken Soup for the Soul" series, at Olivet Nazarene University.

"Charles Betterton's project for the 1990-1992 Community Economic Development Master's program was to establish a National CED Resource Center. In 1998, he turned down a HUD Community Builder Fellowship worth about \$250,000 to continue his non-profit community empowerment work with CENTER SPACE and the University for Successful Living. As one of his faculty advisors 22 years ago, I am grateful for the opportunity to participate in helping 'Dr. Bettertown' continue with his programs, especially the initiatives he has launched in 2012 to combine the new Benefit Corporation model with the Crowd Funding provisions of the JOBS Act and Community Economic Development."
